The data comes from the Reserve Bank of India. This data is GDP at current price and the base years that have been used to calculate this data are 1980-81, 1993-94, 1999-2000, 2004-05 and 2011-12.

Data for other indicators are sourced from: Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), National Family Health Survey (NFHS) 4, Census 2011,Niti Aayog

Annual per capita income of different states



The state with **the highest per-capita income** in the period 2016-17 is **Goa** at an annual per-capita income of INR **3.75 Lakhs.**

The state with the **lowest per-capita income in 2016 is Bihar** with an annual per capita income of **INR 0.34** Lakhs.

The All India annual per-capita income is INR 1.04 Lakhs putting the All India average in the 'Low' category.

A look at the map for per-capita GDP reveals that no Southern State comes into the low or very low per-capita income GDP category. The states with the low per-capita income are concentrated in the North. UP and Bihar are the large states with a very low per-capita income.
